## Johnny test as a dog

Dukey is a hilarious talking dog and the deuteragonist of the Johnny Test series. He's a straight man who often finds himself in trouble when left alone with his owner, Johnny. As a pet, he's got some unique abilities like speaking and walking on two legs, thanks to an experiment gone right by Susan and Mary, Johnny's sisters. Voiced by Louis Chirillo (seasons 1-4) and Trevor Devall (seasons 5 & 6, 2021 reboot), Dukey is more like an older brother to Johnny, offering a humorous and sympathetic voice of reason. He is voiced by several people including Daran Norris, Louis Chirillo, Trevor Devall, Tom Wayland, and others. Dukey's personality is happy, playful, smart, patient, intelligent, and Black. He loves anything that involves meat but dislikes Johnny when he's in trouble. In the show, Dukey usually says "Here's an idea; RUN!" when trouble arises and there's no alternative. Interestingly, his animal instincts were programmed to be Chinese, giving him kung-fu and culinary skills. Despite being poisonous to dogs, Dukey enjoys eating chocolate in some instances.
